RE: TIMELY WARNING: Arson (451 PC; Case SS26-10)

*This Timely Warning is being issued in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Act and the purpose is to provide preventative information to the campus community to aid members from becoming the victim of a similar crime.*

**REPORTED CRIME:** The Sonoma State Police Department is investigating an arson that took place near the Flora complex in Zinfandel Village at approximately noon today.

A witness saw a group of four or five teens setting fire near an outdoor table. The fire was quickly extinguished and caused minor damage.

The teens ran toward Rancho Cotati High School after being seen by the witness. Officers are working with high school administrators in an attempt to identify the teens.

No additional suspect information is available at this time.
